PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2016-2017, a new year for our association, full of projects and achievements allowing us to make the concept of Neuro-Environmental Rehabilitation 21 Century/NER21 better known.

An important achievement ("Highlight 2016") was the workshop which the association offered to several teams from the Western Cape Rehabilitation Centre/WCRC in Cape Town, South Africa. As you could read in Newsletter no. 11, edited by our Vice-President Dr Ursula K Imhof, this seminar following the 2016 AGM of 14 April stimulated keen interest and was a big success. It allowed about thirty members of the WCRC staff (physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, as well as some members of medical and administrative staff) to realize the importance of using the NER21 concept in conjunction with other approaches. The participants reported that using the motivational NER21 scales, developed by three of our members: Marie Julien (speech therapist), Dr. Ursula K Imhof (medical doctor in rehabilitation) and myself (physiotherapist) had proved to be valuable in clinical practice.

Remember that this centre is located in a disadvantaged township and demonstrated that the NER21 concept is flexible and can be effective as a rehabilitation approach in diverse cultural, economic and medical environments.

Holding the AGM in Cape Town allowed the South African members to take part in person for the first time. Because it is not always possible for members to attend meetings in person, nor by Skype, your executive committee proposes to alternate meetings between different continents and country-members of the association in Europe, North America, Africa and why not even in South America!

Interaction between the committee, members and interested persons

Once again there have been numerous meetings and exchanges between members and other interested persons, mainly via e-mails and skype. It is, however, noticeable that the forum provided by the members' website is completely underutilised!

Activities of the Committee

The Committee meet several times, via skype or physically, on 26thJune, 31stJuly, 24thNovember, 20thJanuary, 13thApril. Most of the meetings were dedicated, besides the usual business, to the updating of the NER21 Brochure which will be presented today.

As well as their usual duties, the committee also launched the project of organizing the next congress or seminar of NER21 in Paris, France in 2018!

This project could be started thanks to our member Nicole Sève-Ferrieu, who is one of our Expert Clinicians and also belongs to our College of Experts. Without her agreement to join the ad hoc committee ("Congress 2018, Paris") this idea would not have got off the ground.

Although the contacts established through Nicole Sève-Ferrieu are well advanced, there are still several problems to be solved. We will keep you informed whether it will be possible to hold a congress in a different country from that in which the association is registered. Many problems were experienced with the Canadian administration after the 2014 congress, and you committee is being careful about this issue.

Recognized courses and workshops of the NER21 concept for health professionals

As mentioned before, certificates issued for recognized courses must include the number of effective hours of the course and the official NER21 stamp. An example of the certificate and the list of recipients must be sent to the president. For each recognized course, the committee will propose to this AGM that a financial contribution for the association should be expected from the course's participants. The amount has to be decided related to the numbers of hours but also to the financial situation of the course's location and country. This is to be discussed between the involved educators and the committee.

To date, health professionals (physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech and language therapists, nurses (all degrees), medical practitioners and neuropsychologists) who have trained in France, Switzerland, Germany, Belgium, Canada, Grand-Duché du Luxembourg, Spain, Portugal, Italy, Poland, the USA, Brazil, Argentina and South Africa have received their certificates.

The situation in 2016 is the same as previously. Many members pay the first year's membership fees, but not in the following years, but they still appreciate receiving the newsletters and being able to network!
